

Amendment to Ordinance 200-05

An Ordinance to Regulate Miscellaneous Offenses; Providing for means of enforcement and further providing for penalties for violations; repeal of inconsistent ordinances and ordinances in conflict:

Add Section 26. Removal and disposal of dog waste. No person owning or having custody of any dog shall permit any such dog to defecate on any school ground, public stret, alley, sidewalk, tree bank, park or any other public grounds or any private property within the City other than the premises of the owner or person having custody of the said dog unless defecation is removed immediately and disposed of in an appropriate manner. For enforcement purposes anyone who has the dog on a leash shall be required to have proper equipment to collect the said defecation.
