**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISTURBING THE PEACE; PROVIDING FOR MEANS OF ENFORCEMENT AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION; REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the City of Glenville, to prohibit offenses against the peace in order to protect the welfare of the citizens of the City of Glenville; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENVILLE, THAT:**

That Disturbing The Peace shall be unlawful. No person shall disturb, tend to disturb, or aid in or cause or allow something owned or possessed by him or under his control to disturb the peace of others by riot, noise, disorder or tumult, offensive or obstreperous conduct, and no person shall knowingly permit such disturbance or conduct upon any premises owned, rented or possessed by him or under his control.

**PENALTIES.** Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), or more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), or imprisoned in the City Jail, or Gilmer county Jail for a term, not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both, and any violation continuing from day to day shall constitute separate violations and may be prosecuted as such.

It is the intent of the Common Council of the City of Glenville that each separate provision of this ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein, and it is further the intention of the Common Council of the City of Glenville that if any provision of this ordinance be declared to be invalid, all other provisions therein shall remain valid and in full force and effect, and enforceable.

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, or inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to that extent and no further.

This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon final passage by the Common Council of the City of Glenville.
