

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A CITY OF GLENVILLE ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Glenville deems it necessary and prudent to formally adopt a Road System and thereby proclaiming that any such road and/or street duly adopted by virtue of this Ordinance shall be maintained in accordance with existing policy methods and future policy amendments which may be made by said Council; and

WHEREAS, a set of maps have been prepared to accompany this ordinance with those said roads and/or streets, which are to be included within the City of Glenville Road System, as previously defined, "highlighted" to illustrate their inclusion, and all other roads and/or streets, whether developed, improved, or undeveloped, have not been "highlighted" to illustrate their exclusion from the Road System;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENVILLE:

That this Road System is to be adopted, and

That the Maps shall be placed in City Hall and shall bear the signature of the Mayor and Recorder and the Seal of the City of Glenville and shall thereafter be the official City of Glenville Road System Maps,

That the exclusion of any road, street, or alley from this Road System shall not constitute and in no way be interpreted to constitute a formal abandonment by the City of Glenville of any such excluded road, street, or alley, and

That should anyone desire to have a road, street, or alley, which is excluded from the Road System by this Ordinance, to be included within said Road System by this Ordinance, to be included within said Road System, it must be accomplished by formal resolution passed by the Common Council and attached to this ordinance as an amendment, and

That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, or inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to that extend and no further.
