AN ORDINANCE: Providing for the election of a Municipal Executive Committee, designating the term thereof, and describing its duties.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Town of Glenville: That at the municipal election to be held on the first Tuesday in June, 1949, and each two years thereafter, there shall be elected a Municipal Executive Committee consisting of one member, either male or female, to be elected from each ward within the Town of Glenville.

Said Executive Committee shall be organized and governed, so far as applicable, by the general laws of this State relating to elections. It shall have authority, in event of vacancy on any ballot, or the death of any announced candidate on any ballot, to fill such vacancy not less than five days preceding the date of the election at which said ballot is to be voted upon.

The members of said Committee shall hold office for a term of two years, or until their successors are elected and qualify.
