AN ORDINANCE: NUISANCES. Adopted by the Common council of the Town of Glenville, April 6, 1923.

Be it ordained by the common council of the Town of Glenville, Gilmer County, West Virginia.

That a certain accumulation of garbage and filth, offensive in character and injurious to health, situate and being on that certain lot owned by J. E. Hays, on Court Street; and also on that certain lot and building owned by W. K. Ruddell, adjoining the aforesaid Hays lot, and likewise situate on said Court Street, be, and each of them, by majority of the whole Council, declared a nuisance and injurious to the health and comfort of the persons of said Town of Glenville. The said Hays property being occupied by Cecil Hays, A. C. Garrett, and Miss Stella Furr; and the said Ruddell property being occupied by Charles Bass, Thomas Carroll and family, I. S. Edwards and wife, and O. B. McCartney.

That the said J. E. Hays, Cecil Hays, A.C. Garrett, and Miss Stella Furr, be, and each of them are hereby required to abate the said nuisance affecting the said Hays property by placing the same in a sanitary condition within two days after they and each of them shall be served with a copy of this ordinance, and in case the said J. E. Hays, Cecil Hays, A. C. Garrett, and Miss Stella Furr shall refuse or neglect to comply with this notice, the Mayor shall direct the Street Commissioner of Police to abate the said nuisance in accordance with the requirements aforesaid and to have the same put in order, or removed, and report his proceedings and costs incurred by him to the Mayor; and the owner or lessee of such property shall be liable to a fine or not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00) for neglect or refusal to comply therewith.

That the said W. K. Ruddell, Charles Bass, Thomas Carroll and family, I. S. Edwards and wife, and O. B. McCartney, be, and each of them, are hereby required to abate the said nuisance affecting the said Ruddell property by placing the same in a sanitary condition within two days after they and each of them shall be served with a copy of this ordinance and in case the said W. K. Ruddell, Charles Bass, Thomas Carroll and family, I. S. Edwards and wife, and O. B. McCartney, shall refuse or neglect to comply with this notice the Mayor shall direct the Street Commissioner or Police to abate the said nuisance in accordance with the requirements aforesaid and to have the same put in order, or removed and report his proceedings and costs incurred by him to the Mayor; and the property upon which nuisance exists shall be responsible for the same, and the owner or lessee of such property shall be liable to a fine of not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00) for neglect or refusal to comply therewith.
