AN AMENDMENT TO AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE: IN RELATION TO OFFENSES”

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the City of Glenville, to prohibit the following offenses in order to protect the welfare and safety of the citizens of the City of Glenville, and

WHEREAS, an ordinance regulating miscellaneous offenses was enacted on February 7, 1899 and contains 56 Sections and is found in the Old Ordinance Book at pages 71 through 84. (Now 1000-03; Chapter or Section 38)

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENVILLE:

That Section 38 of the ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE: IN RELATION TO OFFENSES” be amended as follows:

Section 38. Whenever **property conditions** (a privy, hog-pen, stable, building, tree, limbs, or any parts thereof), within said town, shall be by a majority of the whole council declared a nuisance, or injurious to the health or comfort of any person or persons, the owner, agent or lessee of the property shall be notified by the mayor to abate the nuisance within a reasonable amount of time, by removal or keeping in proper order such nuisance; and in case of refusal or negligence to comply with such notice, the mayor shall direct appropriate parties to have the same put in order, or removed, and report their proceedings and the costs incurred by him/her, to the mayor; and the property, upon which such nuisance exists, shall be responsible for the costs of the same; and the owner or lessee of such property shall be liable to a further fine of not exceeding ten dollars, for neglect or refusal to comply, with reasonable promptitude, with the notice, as provided by this section.
