

AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT STREET AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the City of Glenville to protect the investments made into posting of street signs and traffic control signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENVILLE;

The removing, defacing, possession, or otherwise improper and unauthorized use of any and all street signs, traffic control signs, or other sign age placed by the City of Glenville is prohibited.

Any person adjudged guilty and convicted of any first offense established hereunder by the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), plus all court costs.

Any person adjudged guilty and convicted of any second offense established hereunder by the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), plus all court costs.

Any person adjudged guilty and convicted of any third offense established hereunder by the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00).

This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon final passage by the Common Council of the City of Glenville.
