

New Book

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND DESIGNATE TRUCK ROUTES AND PROHIBIT OPERATIONS OF OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES ON ALL OTHER STREETS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF GLENVILLE, WV; PROVIDING FOR MEANS OF ENFORCEMENT AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the City of Glenville to prohibit the following offenses in order to protect the property, welfare, rights and safety of the citizens of the City of Glenville; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENVILLE, THAT;

Section A-1. DEFINITIONS:

Overweight vehicles: for the purpose of this ordinance shall be defined as trucks, trailers, and other conveyances, whether loaded or unloaded, with registered gross weight in excess of 20,000 pounds

Section A-2. DESIGNATION OF TRUCK ROUTES

It is unlawful for any person to operate any overweight vehicle upon any street or alley within the City limits of Glenville, WV except:

- a) North Lewis St
- b) South Lewis St
- c) East Main St
- d) West Main St
- e) Walnut St
- f) Linn St
- g) College St
- h) Mineral Rd
- i) Sycamore Run Rd
- j) North Court St
- k) Conrad Court St
- l) Elm St
- m) High St
- n) Pine St
- o) Medical Drive
- p) Pioneer Way

Section A-3. Designation Access:

All such overweight vehicles shall be required to follow the truck routes but may leave the truck route at that point on the truck route nearest its destination in the city for delivery or pickup of materials, goods and merchandise at a destination not on the marked truck route and the same shall return to the marked truck route by the most direct route.

Section A-4. Exclusions:

School Buses; those trucks engaged in repairing, maintaining, or constructing streets, alleys, utility services, or those engaged in construction of a new building or residence; city-owned, county-owned, or state-owned trucks; solid waste haulers providing to customers within the corporate city limits that may exceed a registered gross weight in excess of 20,000 pounds.

Section A-5. Those areas that are not fit for overweight vehicles have been properly marked with signs stating as such.


Section A-6. Penalties.

Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars. Additionally, any person who is found guilty of this ordinance shall be required to pay court cost and reimburse the City and or Private property owner for any damage to street or property. Damages may be assessed at the cost of the repairs.

This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon final passage by the Common Council of the City of Glenville.


CERTIFICATE OF ENACTMENT
