**AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PARKING AND THE USE OF NORTH COURT STREET AND HOWARD STREET IN THE TOWN OF GLENVILLE, GILMER COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.**

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the Town of Glenville, Gilmer County, West Virginia, to regulate parking and the use of North Court Street and Howard Street within the Town in such a manner to provide adequate motor vehicle parking facilities strategically located so as to facilitate the movement of pedestrians to and from such motor vehicles and the Town's premises located on the corner of North Court Street and Howard Street.

NOW THEREFORE WITNESSETH: That the Common Council of the Town of Glenville, Gilmer County, West Virginia enacts the following:

**SECTION 1: PARKING ON NORTH COURT STREET**

(a) The Mayor through the Street Commissioner is authorized to designate not more than three (3) individual parking spaces along the east side of North Court Street in the block between Main Street and Howard Street as ten (10) minute parking spaces without parking charges.

(b) The ten (10) minute parking spaces will be designated as such by painting the curb or such spaces white with black lettering stating "TEN (10) MINUTE PARKING FOR CITY BUSINESS ONLY" together with any other method of designation, if any, as the Mayor may deem appropriate.

**SECTION 2: PARKING ON HOWARD STREET**

(a) The Mayor through the Street Commissioner is authorized to designate not more than three (3) individual parking spaces along the south side of Howard Street in the block between North Court Street and Rollyson Street as city employee parking spaces without charge. The term city employee as used in is ordinance includes not only full time, part time, temporary and permanent employees but also all elected and appointed officials of the Town of Glenville.

(b) The city employee parking spaces will be designated as such by painting the curb of such spaces white with black lettering stating "CITY EMPLOYEE PARKING ONLY" together with any other method of designation, if any, the Mayor may deem appropriate.

**SECTION 3: VIOLATIONS**

(a) It shall be unlawful for any registered owner, operator, or other person to cause, allow or permit any motor vehicle, whether or not registered in his or her name, to remain in any ten

(10) minute parking space for a period of time exceeding ten (10) minutes, to park in any ten (10) minute parking space for any purpose other than city business, or to park in any city employee parking space unless he or she is a city employee as defined in this ordinance and such motor vehicle displays on the dash visible through the windshield a city employee parking pass captioned "CITY EMPLOYEE PARKING PASS" and signed by the Mayor.

#### SECTION 4: PENALTIES

(a) Any person violating Section 3, paragraph a shall be charged with a violation and may settle and compromise each such charge by depositing ten dollars (\$10.00) together the "ticket" in a designated fine receptacle as herein after described within twenty-four (24) hours.

(b) Failure to settle and compromise any charges within twenty-four (24) hours shall increase the settlement and compromise amount to twenty dollars (\$20.00) which may be deposited at any designated fine receptacle within ten (10) days as aforesaid.

(c) Failure to settle and compromise the charge within ten (10) days shall cause an arrest warrant to be issued and upon conviction the violator shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and will be punished by a fine of not less than thirty dollars (\$30.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus court costs.

#### SECTION 5: FINE RECEPTACLE

(a) There shall be installed at suitable places within the Town of Glenville, under the supervision of the Glenville Police Department, fine receptacle boxes for deposit of money due the Town of Glenville as a result of the violation of Section 3 of this ordinance. Upon receipt of a "ticket" the violator so receiving such notice shall deposit the "ticket" together with the appropriate fine in such fine receptacle. It shall be the responsibility of such violator to properly deposit such fine in the fine receptacle.
