

**CITY OF GLENVILLE**

**AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT UNDERAGE CONSUMPTION**

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the City of Glenville, to prohibit the following offenses in order to protect the welfare and safety of the citizens of the City of Glenville,

THEREFORE, be it ordained that by the Common Council of the City of Glenville that

Section 1. The council shall adopt Chapter 11, Article 16, Section 19 of the WV code (1931) as set forth and amended and as hereinafter amended by the legislature of the State of West Virginia which prohibits underage purchasing, consumption, sale, possession or serving of nonintoxicating beer.

Section 2. The council shall adopt Chapter 60, Article 3A, Section 24 of the WV Code (1931) as set forth and amended and as hereinafter amended by the legislature of the State of West Virginia which prohibits underage purchasing, consumption, sale, possession or serving alcoholic liquor.

Section 3. The council shall adopt Chapter 60, Article 8, Section 20A of the WV Code (1931) as set forth and amended and as hereinafter amended by the legislature of the State of West Virginia which prohibits underage purchasing, consumption, sale possession or serving of wine or other alcoholic liquor.

Section 4. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, or inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to that extent and no further.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date of its final passage.
