

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SPEED LIMIT ON PINE STREET, NORRIS ROAD, SUMAC COURT, AND PARTS OF WALNUT STREET. PROVIDING FOR MEANS OF THE ENFORCEMENT AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS: REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT AND ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Common Council of the City of Glenville to prohibit the following offenses in order to protect the property, welfare and safety of the citizens of the City of Glenville, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENVILLE, THAT: THE FOLLOWING OFFENSE SHALL BE UNLAWFUL.

It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to drive said vehicle at a speed greater than fifteen miles per hour (15mph), on Pine Street, where it intersects with Sumac Court, to where it intersects with Walnut Street. Norris Road, where it intersects with Sumac Court, to where it intersects with Walnut Street. Sumac Court, where it intersects with Pine Street, to where it intersects with Norris Road, Walnut Street, where it intersects with Main Street, to where it intersects with Center Street.

PENALTIES: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and/or be imprisoned in the City Jail, or Gilmer County Jail for a term, not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both, for each violation of any provision of this ordinance.

It is the intent of the Common Council of the City of Glenville that any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provision herein, and it is further the intentions of the Common Council of the City of Glenville that if any provision of this ordinance be declared to be invalid, all other provisions therein shall remain valid and in full force and effect, and enforceable.

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, or inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent and no further.

This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon final passage by the Common Council of the City of Glenville.
