New Book

AN ORDINANCE to provide for laying off the Town of Glenville into wards, and providing boundaries thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the Town of Glenville that said Town be divided into five wards, as follows:

- WARD NO. 1:** To contain and consist of that part of the original corporation of Glenville which lies within Voting Precinct No. 23.
- WARD NO. 2:** To contain and consist of that part of the original corporation of Glenville which lies within Voting Precinct No. 16 and that part of the present corporation known as Collins Addition, which was voted into said corporation on June 25, 1946, and bounded and described on page 253 in the official minute books of the town of Glenville.
- WARD NO. 3:** To contain and consist of that part of the present corporation known as Northview and Hays City Addition, which were voted into said corporation on June 25, 1946, and bounded and described on page 253 in the official minute books of the town of Glenville.
- WARD NO. 4:** To contain and consist of that part of the present corporation lying South of the Little Kanawha River and known as Brooklyn Addition and South Glenville, and bounded by said river and the line between said Brooklyn addition and Camden Flats Addition, as described on page 12 in the official minute book of the Town of Glenville and by the southern limits of the Town of Glenville as described on page 253 in said official minute book.
- WARD NO. 5:** To contain and consist of that part of the Camden Flats Addition to the Town of Glenville which was voted into the corporate limits of said town on May 24, 1949, and bounded and described on page 12 in the official minute book of said Town of Glenville.
